Steve Highfill is the Regional Director of EFCA West, a service arm of the Evangelical Free Church of America. He grew up on a cattle ranch in Northern New Mexico, earned a B.S. in pre-medical studies at Colorado State University, served on staff with Campus Crusade for Christ in New York City (during which time he was Chaplain to the New York Jets), and then earned a Masters of Divinity from Talbot Theological Seminary (Biola University). He was the founding pastor of the Cypress Evangelical Free Church (near Knott's Berry Farm), where he served for twelve years before being elected to become the District Superintendent for the EFCA churches in Southern California. He is now in his sixth year of overseeing the nearly 200 EFCA churches throughout Central and Southern California, Arizona, New Mexico, Las Vegas, and El Paso.
